**Geely Automobile Holdings Limited**  
**SALES VOLUME FOR SEPTEMBER 2012 REACHED 43,055 UNITS**  
**SALES VOLUME UP 33% YOY**

(HONG KONG, 11 October 2012) --- Geely Automobile Holdings Limited ("Geely Automobile"/the "Group")(Stock code: 175) announced that the total sales volume of the Group for the month of September 2012 was 43,055 units, an increase of approximately 33% over the same period last year and up approximately 43% from August 2012. The total sales volume in the first three quarters of 2012 was 323,938 units, up approximately 11% from the same period last year and achieving approximately 70% of the 2012 full year sales volume target of 460,000 units. The Group's exports sales remained strong during the period. Its export volume was over 11,600 units in September 2012. The Group's sales volume in the China market also recovered strongly, achieving around 11% increase from the same period last year to over 31,400 units in September 2012.

The Spokesmen of Geely Automobile said, "During the month of September 2012, the Group's sale volumes under 'Emgrand', 'Englon' and 'GLEagle' brands were 15,385 units, 12,368 units and 15,302 units, respectively. The sales volume of GX7, the Group's first Sport Utility Vehicle (SUV), increased about 46% to 4,544 units in September 2012 from the previous month."

The sales volume figures released so far are based on a more stringent recognition criterion, requiring all sales to be contracted, paid and delivered before it would be recognized. These figures, however, are still preliminary figures and would be subject to changes and final confirmation.
